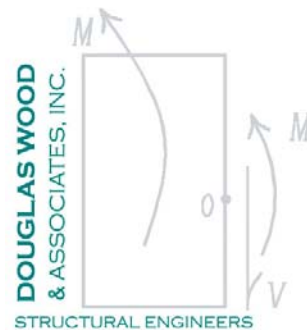
- Mr. Hadjez has 9 years experience in the field of structural engineering.
